RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS

At the **Vigil Mass this weekend**, we have the **Second in a series of three special rites for Lorraine Ashcroft**, an “elect” preparing for her Baptism at the Easter Vigil. These **special prayers** are called ***The Scrutinies***. The word **“Scrutiny”** suggests **self-searching** – which is something we all try to do during the Lenten period as we try to uncover and be healed of anything that is sinful or weak in our lives.

The celebrant lays hands on the head of the elect, and in a prayer inspired by the Sunday Gospel story, prays she will open her heart to receive the gifts of the Saviour in Baptism. The Gospel this week deepens our faith in Christ, our Redeemer, who is the light of the world, as we listen to the story of the healing of the man born blind.

During the prayer of exorcism, the congregation are invited to stand, extending your hands towards Lorraine and supporting her with your prayer.

The **Third Scrutiny** will take place at the **Vigil Mass next weekend**.

THE SACRAMENT OF PENANCE FOR LENT

An important part of our preparation for Easter is to celebrate the Sacrament of God's loving forgiveness and healing – the Sacrament of Penance or Reconciliation.

You are invited to the **Second Rite of Penance** in St. Joseph's Church on **Tuesday 24th March** at **10AM** and **7PM**.

We prepare together with Prayer, Scripture, Examination of Conscience and Hymns and then have the opportunity to go to one of the two Priests at 10AM or one of the three Priests 7PM for **Individual Confession** and to receive **Sacramental Absolution**.

Plan to celebrate the Second Rite of Penance on Tuesday 24th March at 10AM or 7PM.

CHRISM MASS: Parishioners are invited to join (in person or in spirit) with Bishop Robert McGuckin and the Priests of the Diocese in **St. Patrick's Cathedral** on **Monday 30th April** at **5.30PM** for the **Consecration of Chrism** and the **Blessing of the Holy Oils** for use in the Sacraments for the next year.

- † **Holy Chrism** is used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Ordination of a Priest.
- † **The Oil of Catechumens** is also used in Baptism and to anoint adult Catechumens preparing for Baptism.
- † **The Oil of the Sick** is used for the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick.

The **Holy Oils** will be **received into our Parish** at the **Mass of The Lord's Supper** on **Holy Thursday** evening.
